Statement on the Brutal Killings in Nyaingamuda, Bori Boma, Kangapo II Payam, Kajo-Keji County

The Office of the Commissioner of Kajo-Keji County expresses its deepest concern over the recent tragic incident involving the targeted killing of civilians in Nyaingamuda Village, Bori Boma, Kangapo II Payam.

On the evening of June 13th, 2025, at approximately 7:00 PM, suspected armed youth—believed to be hold-out groups—carried out a violent attack that resulted in the deaths of three individuals and left another injured. The assailants remain at large.

Confirmed Fatalities:

1. **Julius Loke (82)** – Male, Headman of Nyaingamuda Village, Bori Boma, Kangapo II Payam.
2. **Stanley Wani Phillip** – Medical personnel and resident of Nyaingamuda Village, Bori Boma, Kangapo II Payam.
3. **Simaya Lodu James (27)** – Youth and resident of Liwolo, Liwolo Payam.

Confirmed Injury:

1. **Tunda Bosco (19)** – Male, sustained a gunshot wound with a bullet entry through the left lateral foot, causing damage to tarsal muscles and resulting in an open fracture.

These acts of violence are not only inhumane but destabilize the county, spreading fear among residents and obstructing progress toward sustainable development.

I, Wani Jackson Mule, the Commissioner of Kajo-Keji County hereby reaffirms the government's unwavering commitment to peace and stability. I announce a looming deployment of a Joint Operation Force to the affected area urging residents to cooperate with the security personnel to ensure protection of lives and property.

I encourage the local population to resume their daily routines and continue coexisting peacefully, assuring that the government is in control and actively working to restore calm.



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Furthermore, I extend an open call to all community leaders, religious leaders, civil society organizations, political representatives, business owners, youth and residents to unite in support of Kajo-Keji's peace and development agenda.
